



Triple Cube card



Caption

I've used the Touch of Ink or Berry Blessing Stamps

- * One piece of card, 29.7 x 14.8cm in blushing bride or pacific point

- * Two pieces of card 29.7 x 7cm in same colour used as above

- * Dsp 10 pieces 6.5cm square, 4 pieces 14.2 x 6.5cm, alternatively white card stamped and cut to these dimensions leave 2 of the larger pieces unstamped for the back.

- * The base card pieces are all scored at 7,14,21 and 28cm

- * Give all the scores a good crease.

- * with the large piece in landscape and the tab to the right attach 2 of the larger mats to the left hand panel and the far right panel then put glue/ tape on the tab and attach to make a cube.

- * with the smaller pieces in a portrait position glue 2 small mats to the bottom panel and the top panel and as before fold of and glue the tab so to make a cube. Ensure that the direction of you stamping or dsp is correct.

- * put the front of the card on a score board and score from the bottom centre mark diagonally to the fold top right hand side and repeat to the lefthand side. Fold as mountain folds

- * And from the side marks score to the bottom centre mark both sides and fold as valley folds

- * on the dsp mark on the long edge at the bottom centrally at 7.1cm and cut from that mark diagonally to the top right corner and repeat from the centre mark diagonally to the left top corner.

- * attach the large triangular piece to the front of the arrow and the smaller pieces to the inside of the card

- * Attach the small cubes to the larger cube at the bottom of 2 adjacent panels with the opening to the side. To put in an envelope they will sit flat up the card

- * colours used, white, pacific point, old olive, pear pizzazz, blushing bride, smokey slate, rich razzleberry, so saffron, soft sea foam, Bermuda bay, pool party. I've used a combination of ink pads and stamping write markers.
